Devonport

Seaside charm and quiet villa-lined streets, Devonport provides a perfect afternoon ride. The village is home to a collection of cafés, art galleries, quaint shops and The Vic theatre.

Torpedo Bay Naval Museum

Devonport has been a naval base since 1841. The Navy Museum at Torpedo Bay celebrates this rich local history and that of New Zealand's maritime roots.

Maungauika - North Head

Maungauika - North Head, has a fascinating history. First a Maori settlement, and then as a coastal fortification from 1870 to the end of WWII.

Cheltenham Beach

A lovely sandy shallow beach, perfect for an afternoon swim. Rest in the shade of a pohutukawa tree or pop up to the shops where you'll find everything from delicious eats to antiques. Pedal up to Fort Takapuna along the shared path, or cut through by the French bakery, for a flat on-road ride to Narrow Neck.

Narrow Neck beach

Home of the Wakatere Boating Club. On Sundays, dinghies sail around the bay with Rangitoto in the background. There is also a café and playground, it's an easy ride from Devonport.

Bayswater Bridge

Beyond Takapuna Grammar school there are stunning views of the gulf. Loop back through Northboro Reserve and over Bayswater Bridge past historic O'Neill's Point Cemetery. If you need refueling, Eversleigh Road's Little & Friday is famous for their cream filled doughnuts.

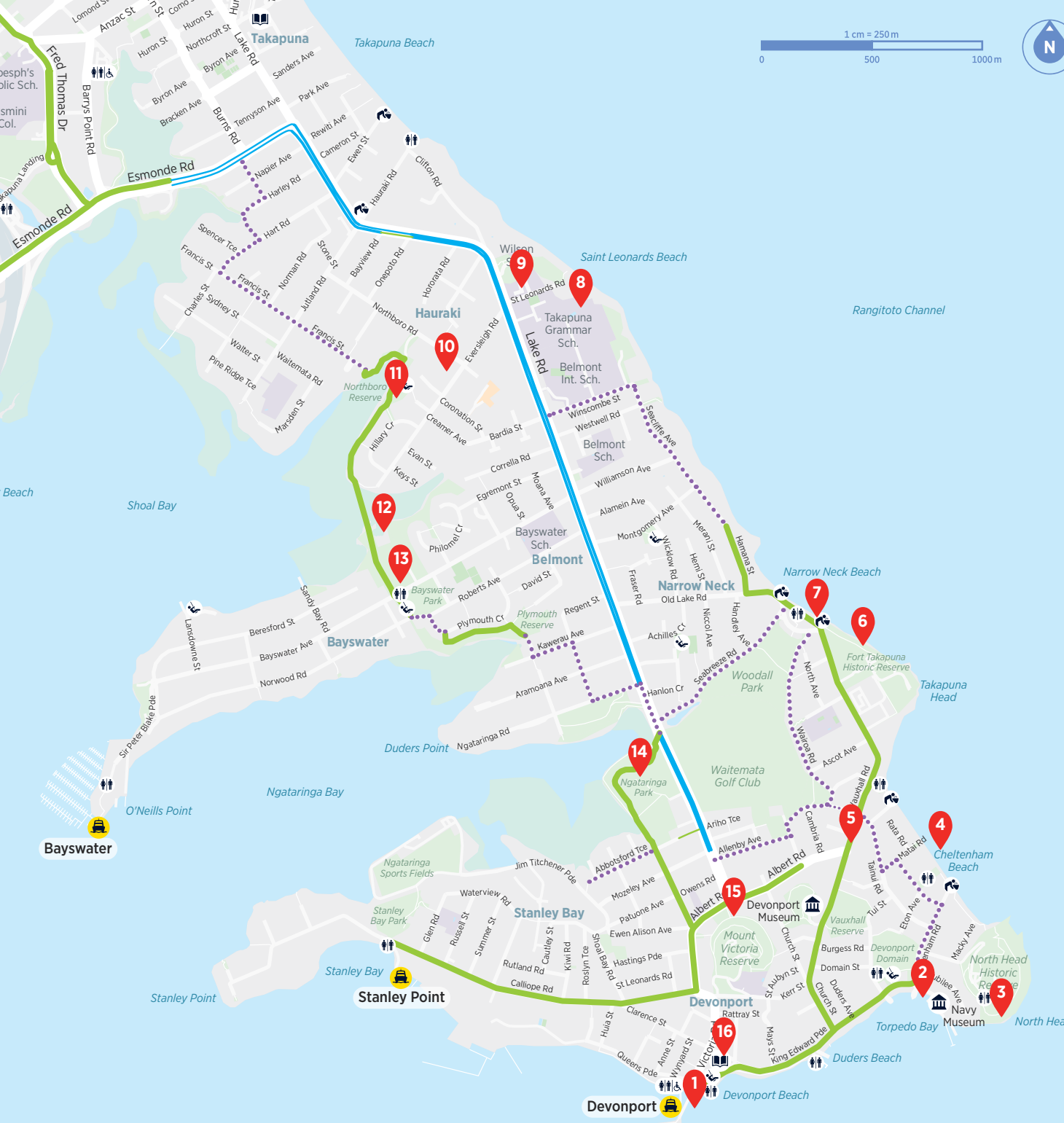


Devonport is the starting point for numerous bike rides, offering great views across to the city and Rangitoto.

DEVONPORT TO TAKAPUNA



Routes: one way

The Devonport to Takapuna Green Route weaves through parks, mangroves and heritage streets on paths, boardwalks and bridges. Along the way there's a nautical themed playground at Northboro Reserve, eels to spot in the mangroves, and plenty of history at North Shore's oldest cemetery which was founded in 1891. For a shorter ride head from Devonport out to Narrow Neck. This coastal ride offers fantastic views and is gently undulating, passing by beautiful local beaches and reserves.
